ADVICE FOR IMPORTING FROM AUTODESK RECAP

3DUserNetVISION

Autodesk Recap is a free software commonly used as a free viewer of pointcloud data on local computers. 3DUserNet can now take in the Project format (.rcp) which can then be viewed from anywhere with access to internet.

To ensure that all files are uploaded to 3DUserNet, you first need to export your project from Recap. As 3DUserNet will view your data as a single pointcloud object (per upload) you should unify your project on export. The steps are shown below:


(a) Load your project in Recap




(b) Select Export from the top menu



(c) Export as a unified RCP Project



(d) Confirm in the next window - let's go!



(e) This will produce a file and a support folder



Lastly before uploading, both these files need to be compressed into a .zip file.
